### **Certificate of Analysis (CoA) Statement**

A Certificate of Analysis (CoA) is not provided; however, a Certificate of Conformance (CoC) statement is included on each packing list for every shipment.

Customers are responsible for determining that the use of the product(s) is safe, lawful, and technically suitable for their intended applications.

This certificate is continuous and shall remain in full force and effect unless revoked in writing. This version supersedes all previous certificates or declarations that may otherwise be in effect.
