## **PFAS (Absence) Compliance Statement**

This statement is to confirm to the best knowledge of the company, finished goods manufactured by **Inline Plastics Corp.** do not contain PFAS material.

Products provided to **Inline Plastics Corp.** do not contain Per- and Polyfluoroalkyl Substances (PFAS, PFC, PFHxS) as that term is defined by the Organization for Economic Cooperation and Development (OECD) or the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA.) To the best of our knowledge, these compounds are also not present in the product and do not exceed the reportable threshold of 0.1%.

**Inline Plastics Corp.**'s primary sheet suppliers have provided notification that they do not intentionally add any food substances or products listed in Regulation EU 1169/2011 including but not limited to Perfluoroalkyl or Polyfluoroalkyl Substances (PFAS Substances).

As a consequence, **Inline Plastics Corp.**'s sheet material, hence its products, are in compliance with state requirements that food packaging does not contain intentionally added PFAS. This includes California, Colorado, Connecticut, Hawaii, Maine, Maryland, Minnesota, New York, Oregon, Rhode Island, Vermont and Washington.

It is the responsibility of the processor, producer, packager or importer of the finished consumer product to determine consumer safety and ensure compliance with all international, federal, state and local regulations of PFAS substances.

Customers must make their own determination that the use of the product(s) is safe, lawful, and technically suitable in the intended applications.

This certificate is continuing and shall remain in full force and effect until revoked in writing. This version supersedes all previous certificates that might otherwise be effective.
