## **Letter for Certificate of Analysis (CoA)**

**Inline Plastics Corp.** does not produce the plastic sheet that is used to form the containers that we supply to our customers. We do however; require our suppliers of the plastic sheet to supply us with a Certificate of Conformance certifying the FDA requirements for food contact.

**Inline Plastics Corp.** certifies the raw material plastic sheet, that produces our products, is compliant with the FDA requirements for food contact. A Certificate of Analysis (COA) is not required, however, our Certificate of Conformance (CoC) statement is printed on each packing list for each shipment.

You must make your own determination that your use of the product(s) is safe, lawful, and technically suitable in your intended applications.

This certificate is continuing and shall remain in full force and effect until revoked in writing. This version supersedes all previous certificates that might otherwise be effective.
